- Prices in general are less than online prices because we have the advantage of group bookings that not only includes discounted prices but also additional benefits of a group such as custom Indian meals, group activities such as Bollywood night & group tours.
- Royal Caribbean will automatically add a \$13.50 USD gratuity for standard staterooms, \$16.50 USD for Suite guests, to each guest's account on a daily basis; that is \$13.50/\$16.50 per person per day.
- Additional gratuities, IAVA Event charges & Miscellaneous: Approx. \$100.00/Cabin
- Similar for profit Organized Cruises catering to Indian guests (example Masala Cruises), typically can charge more than twice these prices for a comparable experience

RULES & POLICIES:

- Royal Caribbean policies and rules will apply and must be followed by all.
- IAVA is not responsible for any reservations denied, cancellations, room quality, food, VISA or any other issues one might have. You will have to take it up directly with the cruise line.
- Fuel supplement charges may be levied by the cruise line across the board if the price of oil per barrel reaches above a certain threshold.
- We do not have much flexibility with room assignments as cruise line allocates rooms based upon group rates and other factors.
- Booking rooms in vicinity may be really difficult and cruise line/IAVA will first give preference to cabins from the same family to be placed close to each other. Even that cannot be guaranteed.
- Maximum of 2 cabins/rooms can be booked in the same reservation.

DETAILS NEEDED FOR ALL TRAVELERS

- Name as per passport
- Date of Birth
- Nationalities
- Room Types not guaranteed until final payment to cruise line/agent
- All guests including infants will be charged by the cruise line and need to be on the reservation. Name changes, adding or removing guests is generally not possible after the reservation and cruise line policies apply.

PAYMENT DETAILS

- Entire Payment to be made directly to the cruise line or its travel agent. IAVA will not collect any payments other than for conducting IAVA event on board or minor gratuities (see “Cabin Cost” section for guidelines).

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Only some cabins on cruise can accommodate up to 4 travelers. If you have 3rd and 4th traveler in the same room, please choose appropriate cabin type while booking.
- Single occupancy rooms are not available
- Excursions can be booked directly with the cruise line either in advance or on the ship. IAVA may consider arranging popular group excursion or other community events in due course and emails will be sent to all registered guests.

INCLUSIONS IN ABOVE CRUISE COST

- 5 Night stay in cabin category selected by the traveler
- Meals, when on cruise

EXCLUSIONS IN ABOVE CRUISE COST

- Airfare or transportation to and from Miami port
- Pre and Post hotel accommodation and Tours
- Excursions during cruise
- Meals during Excursions

- As determined by the cruise line

VISA DETAILS

· All Nationalities: Please check Visa requirement directly with concerned consulate. Note that the cruise will travel to ports in Mexico and the policies should be confirmed with Mexican consulate. Keep in mind that countries sometimes have different policies for cruise line and air travelers.

Ensure that you and your family satisfy all the conditions before submitting your form.

BOOKING PROCESS

- Submit the fully completed IAVA reservation form to confirm your participation. Please be absolutely sure of participation, type of accommodation, lead name on the reservation, number of rooms, number of persons in each room, family member names etc. before submitting as we will reserve your spot with the cruise line agent upon receiving your request.
- Once we receive your reservation, we will hold your room depending upon availability and provide you the exact cost via email within 24 to 48 hours. You will then have 48 hours to call a number and make payment along with additional details required by the cruise line or its agent. They will assign you your room number based upon the room type chosen and confirm your reservation.
- Any information submitted should be accurate such as all legal names (as in your passport/legal document), age, phone number & email address as the reservation will be made using the details provided.
- If there is any confusion or an incomplete application, we may have to cancel your reservation. We will do our best to contact you; so please provide accurate phone numbers and email addresses that you check often. Note that time will be of essence and once cancelled we have no control and do not hold us responsible for any miscommunication.
- The cost shown in the table above is very close to accurate but we will only be able to tell the exact amount based upon when your entry is received (first-come first-serve to get the lowest price in a given category). The price of rooms we have reserved varies slightly, so the final cost may change somewhat.
- Go thoroughly through this document as well as the FAQ document before making a reservation. Sample calculations have been shown in the FAQ document that should help you come up to an approximate cost for your party/family.
